



LogV PROJECT – SA Navy

The SA Navy is currently in the process of migrating all their Weapon Systems and Stores to a new Information Management System. One of the key principles of this effort is to ensure the data used to populated OSIS (Operational Support Information System) is verified and a true reflection of the physical condition of items. Data integrity is therefore of the highest importance to the SA Navy, in order to ensure that the Information System reflects the actual state and condition of these assets.

TFD Africa is responsible to prepare the data before migration into OSIS. This is accomplished by means of the “Clean-Up Process”.

Various Weapon Systems and Depot’s formed part of the TFD Africa effort is as follows:

This process enhanced the implementation of OSIS for the SA Navy, resulting in Quality errors of less than 2% with the following additional results:
